

#### Module 1: Assessment of The Face for Dynamic Wrinkles

After completing this module, you will be able to:

- 1. Assess patients' concerns and determine the root cause of underlying issues
- 2. Assess if neurotoxin should be utilized and if so, how much
- 3. Determine where neurotoxin should be injected, and the impact of its placement on other areas of the face
- 4. Consult with a patient before, during and after treatment
- 5. Discuss treatment planning, expectations management and results assessment
- 6. Discuss common safety features and product misconceptions
- 7. Treat a wide variability of patients across different ages, genders and ethnicities
- 8. Understand what type of results you can achieve based upon the scope of procedures offered at your practice

# Module 2: Upper Face – Forehead, Glabella, Crow's Feet/Lateral Canthal Lines, Bunny Lines/Nasalis

After completing this module, you will be able to:

- 1. Understand patients' concerns to build a treatment plan that delivers desired results
- 2. Know when to treat an individual area vs. all areas
- 3. How to properly inject preventative neurotoxin in younger patients
- 4. Determine maximum dosage without producing adverse side effects (droopy eyelids, heavy brows, etc.)
- 5. How to determine if a patient is a good candidate for a neurotoxin brow lift
- 6. How to properly administer a neurotoxin brow lift

## Module 3: Perioral - Lips, Chin, DAO

After completing this module, you will be able to:

- 1. Properly inject neurotoxin in the upper and lower lip vertical lines
- 2. Assess when to use neurotoxin alone versus in combination with other treatments (e.g., fillers, laser, etc.)
- 3. Enhance lip visibility through correcting gummy smiles
- 4. Correct downturning in the marionette area (corners of the mouth) though the use of neurotoxin alone or in combination with filler
- 5. Treat chin wrinkles (cobble stoning)

#### **Module 4: Neck**

After completing this module, you will be able to:

- 1. Determine which concerns in the neck are treatable with neurotoxin
- 2. Address common misconceptions of neurotoxin use in the neck



3. Manage expectations regarding result possibilities, number of treatments required and the potential need for additional treatment.

## **Module 5: Cosmetic Migraine and TMJ**

After completing this module, you will be able to:

- 1. Determine when you alone can treat a patient and when a neurology or dental/oral surgery referral is required
- 2. Determine if patients' concerns can be treated with a "cosmetically pleasing" dose
- 3. Titrate treatment dosage depending on the severity of a patient's concern without compromising cosmetic results
- 4. Identify the degree to which specific areas are contributing to a patient's concerns
- 5. Communicate with the patient about the number of treatments required to achieve their desired results
