

## Hands-On Training Terms & Conditions

A member of our team will conduct a follow-up call with all applicants to process applications and confirm requirements have been met. Those who are not approved for the hands-on training will have their course fee reimbursed with the exception of processing fees. Seiler Skin Aesthetic Institute (SSAI) reserves the right to deny applicants if they do not meet the requirements outlined.

- The Seiler Skin Aesthetic Institute's online filler training course must be completed prior to hands-on training.
- Physicians must have at least six months of neurotoxin and filler experience if attending the neurotoxin, filler and/or Vampire<sup>®</sup> trainings. This experience not required for O-Shot<sup>®</sup>/P-Shot<sup>®</sup>, training, but six months of aesthetic experience preferred.
- Full Vampire weekend seminar trains on all six Vampire<sup>®</sup> procedures (Vampire Facial<sup>®</sup>, Vampire Facelift<sup>®</sup>, Vampire Breastlift<sup>®</sup>, O-Shot<sup>®</sup>, P-Shot<sup>®</sup>, and Vampire Hair Restoration.). All are taught over the course of two days and trainees will pay same fee regardless of which procedures they are interested in.
- Non-physicians must have a licensed physician who also comes (or has previously completed) a Vampire<sup>®</sup> seminar. Non-physicians can attend just the Vampire Facial<sup>®</sup> but must have a Medical Director sign off.
- Trainees are required to volunteer to be treated with different procedures and/or bring someone to treat.
- 1-2 syringes of filler will be provided for training. If a trainee wants more filler training and time allows, they are responsible for supplying additional syringes.
- All attendees will be required to sign up with the ACCMA/CMA and join the fee-based membership as these trainings are for Dr. Runel's trademarked procedures.
- CME credit will be given for part or the entire training involving injections and PRP treatments.
- You will be required to sign several documents at the time of your hands-on training, including but not limited to:
  - Disclaimers/disclosures and release of liability
  - CME forms (this is part of the full online disclaimer/disclosure)
  - ACCMA/CMA membership/payment forms
  - Patient confidentiality
  - Patient intake, consent and photo release (for certain procedures) for treatments you receive
  - o Attestment to your medical licensure and existence of medical director (if non-MD)
